Confidentiality Statement

The National Indian Child Care Association wishes to protect its confidential information from unauthorized disclosure. Members of the Board of Directors may have access to confidential and proprietary information. It is the responsibility of members of the Board of Directors to keep such information strictly confidential. Such information may include financial statements and financial information, information submitted to Board members for Committee meetings, information about members and prospective members, methods of operation, fees and charges, dealing with agencies, personnel affairs, marketing decisions, business strategies and plans, special events, sponsors and sponsorships, and other information pertaining to the business and affairs of the Association.

Members of the Board of Directors shall not publish, distribute, communicate, disclose, or divulge information of a confidential nature during their term of service on the Board of Directors or afterwards, except as may be contemplated in connection with their usual Board service and activities (such as, when contacting members, planning special events, meeting with consultants and other routine Board activities) or as may generally be approved by the Board of Directors.
